VIII. OLD BUSINESS:

We received the release from the Dinges lawsuit. Case closed.

Still working on quotes for the front fountains and small island on Bellini Way landscaping.

Filed 4 small claims cases with the Superior Court. Two of the owners have made payments. One has requested a payment arrangement and one has paid the HOA dues for 2019-2020 and 2020-2021.

Irrigation System on Virtue Arc at the end of the tennis courts has been repaired and is now providing water to the trees and grass area is improving. Cost \$1400.00.

IX. NEW BUSINESS and Open Forum:

Quick Books accounting system: We have been using Quick Books Desktop accounting system since 2010 at a current cost of \$299.00 per year, plus their auto backup at a cost of \$199.00 per year total cost \$498.00. To use the desktop version we must have a reliable computer and only one person can access the program at a time. To make our accounting system more accessible to those who need it and remove the need for an association computer purchase, I would like to recommend that we convert our current desktop plan over to Quick Books online system. The first-year cost would be \$810.00. This will allow any approved user access to the accounting system from their own computer or device from anywhere. It will allow our Accountant to have limited access to our records for our annual tax returns. In the long run we will be saving money in the time required to prepare tax information, the convenience of access, reduced equipment and supply cost.
