Pool:

Still closed and being serviced regularly.

Golf Course:

The golf course excess water has been drained into the large pond. Still waiting for the ground to dry up before the debris around the course can be removed.

The tee boxes have been cut and removed. Cesar will have a crew come in to prep the ground for new sod to be install the second week of February.

Tree removal still being completed. Lots of trees need trimming, will get bid for next year. Balance available in this year's budget is \$2,000.

Called City of Stockton and waiting for their inspection of the issue. Received a bid to remove the tree and the roots that have lifted the street \$3,500. We have placed caution tape around the island warning the residence of the hazard.
